Thank you for taking the time to consider Meoncross for your child. We are proud to be a through school, from 2.5 to 16 years. Students will automatically continue to their next stage of schooling (Nursery to Infants, Infants to Juniors, Juniors to Seniors) without the need to reapply. We welcome applications for entry into Nursery to Year 9 inclusive, at any point in the academic year. Every application is treated equally, and we welcome students from all backgrounds.



VISIT US

We encourage everyone to come and visit us here at Meoncross. It's important for students and parents alike to get a real feel for what it is like to be part of our school community. School in Action Open Mornings and personal tailor-made tours are both available throughout the academic year, to enable you to see a true reflection of a day in the life at Meoncross. You will see students engaged in the lessons of the day and can ask them and our teaching staff any questions you may have.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is simple and straightforward, and our Admissions Team are on hand to help you through every step.

APPLY FOR A PLACE

You can complete the online registration from the comfort of your own home by visiting the Apply for a Place page in the Admissions section on our website. There is a non-refundable registration fee of £150. Your child will then be invited to join their current year group for two consecutive taster days where they will take part in academic and social assessments. Subsequent feedback and an offer of a place are given at a meeting with the Headmaster.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The official school outfitter is **JohnLewis.com** and the Southampton store holds a full set of uniform for fitting purposes. Items can be ordered in store or online and delivered to your home address, or to a local Waitrose store by the 'Click and Collect' service. Sibling Discounts

We are delighted to offer the following discount structure for students attending Meoncross in Years R–11:

First Child	Full published fees
Second Child in Attendance	5% discount on published fees
Younger Third Child in Attendance	10% discount on published fees
Younger Fourth/Fifth Children in Attendance	15% discount on published fees

For any duration, when a pupil may be eligible for more than one financial award e.g. a sibling discount and a Scholarship, only the value of the greater award will be applied to school fees.

NURSERY FEES

Meoncross Nursery is open for 38 weeks of the year; during term time from 8.30am until 4pm. The 38 weeks consist of the standard 36 weeks of term time, plus the first week of the summer holiday and the first week of the Christmas holiday.

Session times

Early Bird 8.30am – 9am

Core Hours 9am – 4pm

Morning (not inc lunch) 9am – 12noon

Morning (inc lunch) 9am – 1pm

Afternoon (inc lunch) 12noon – 4pm

Afternoon (not inc lunch) 1pm – 4pm

All above are charged at £7.90 per hour.

EARLY YEARS FUNDING

Three and four year olds can claim their 15 funded hours at Meoncross from the term after their third birthday. Early years funding can be claimed against all the hours the Nursery is open, from 8.30am – 4pm. All hours in addition to the 15 funded hours are charged at the advertised rate.

ENHANCED PROVISION CHARGE

The morning and afternoon core sessions include Ballet, French, Music, Drama, PE and Beach School, all taught by qualified teachers/specialist staff. There is an enhanced provision charge of £2.63 for every funded hour claimed by children eligible for the EYE Grant during these core sessions.
